### **Certificate of Conformity.**

A batch of 'Teatools', stated as being composed of Hostaform C 9021 14, have been provided to Smithers Rapra for migration testing. Tests to show conformity to the current EC food legislation under the following conditions have been requested:

Distilled water simulant, 30 minutes cooling from reflux temperature

50% ethanol simulant, 30 minutes cooling from reflux temperature

Under these conditions, the 'Teatools' have been found to comply with EC Directive 2002/72/EC and amendments and UK Statutory Instrument 2006/1401 for overall migration with data obtained being within the limit of 10mg/dm<sup>2</sup>.

The specific migration of formaldehyde was found to be within the EC Directive limit of 15mg/Kg.

The specific migration of 1,3-dioxolane and 1,3,5-trioxane was found to be within the EC Directive limit of 5mg/Kg (for each substance).

All testing was undertaken between August and September 2008.  
Data is as reported in Rapra CTR number 49333, project number AQ0305.

Smithers Rapra is a UKAS accredited Testing Laboratory number 0067.
